## COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

**Morning Program (Gr. K-5):** Come join us to explore books, play games and finish homework before school. All grades are welcome! **FEE: \$15/\$30**

## AFTERNOON PROGRAM

**Homework Club (Project iSucceed)(Gr. 3-5):** Students will have an opportunity to complete homework, classwork and nightly reading assignments. **NO FEE**

**Academic Hour:** Come complete your homework, or work on your school projects with help from our staff. **NO FEE**

**BINGO! & Board Games:** Students will improve their math, literacy and social skills while playing BINGO & popular board and card games. **FEE: \$15/\$30**

**Pinterest Club:** Students will look up fun activities on the popular Pinterest Board Site and decide as a class which project they will create and take home. **FEE: \$15/\$30**

**Martial Arts:** Learn the forms and technique of Martial Arts with instructor Aaron Butler. **FEE: \$15/\$30**

**Sports:** Learn about proper stretching, endurance and play sports in an enjoyable and beneficial hour-long club with Mr. Leclerc. **NO FEE**

**City Year/FIRST Lego League: (FULL Cont. From Session 2)** Students will work as scientists and engineers in this years "Animal Allies" themed robotics club. Teams will build, test, and program a LEGO robot to solve ne missions and create a project to solve real-world questions about animals.

**BYPC Dance:** Come explore the world of dance with the professionals from the Bedford Youth Performing Company. **FEE: \$15/\$30**

**Playground Fun:** We will get out weather permitting and play some new and old playground games with colorful balls, jump ropes chalk and more. **NO FEE**

**Story Arts:** Listen to a great story and then create an art project to go along with it. **NO FEE**

**Jewelry Making:** Come and learn some new techniques of jewelry making with beads and tools. **FEE: \$15/\$30**

**Paper Mache:** Experience mixing the pulp and create your very own artistic masterpiece. Taught by McDonough's own art teacher: Ms. Provencher. Each class is limited to 8 students. **FEE: \$15/\$30**

**Coloring Arts:** Come relax with an hour of coloring Mandalas, animals and simple adult coloring books. **NO FEE**

**FIRST Jr. LEGO League (FULL Cont. From Session 2)** Explore LEGO Robotics through this introductory class that teaches you how to add moving parts to your LEGO creations. Attendance is critical for this class

**iPads:** Play educational games on the iPads with your fellow classmates. **NO FEE**

**Spring Art:** Learn about the signs of spring and incorporate them in your art by re-creating flowers, bugs, and birds. Students will use materials such as oil pastels, pipe cleaners and other fun art materials. **FEE: \$15/\$30**

**Starfish Corp: (FULL Cont. From Session 2)** Explore the basic building blocks of community and leadership, while contributing to the wellbeing of others through service and other acts of compassion. Taught by the City Year Corps participants.

**Pony Beads:** Students will design their own one of a kind pieces by making necklaces and bracelets with Pony Beads. **FEE: \$15/\$30**

**FIRST Jr. LEGO League (FULL Cont. From Session 2)** Explore LEGO Robotics through this introductory class that teaches you how to add moving parts to your LEGO creations. Attendance is critical for this class

**Open Rec:** Have fun choosing from different types of recreational activities in the gym or outside. **FEE: \$15/\$30**

**SCA:** Join the Student Conservation Association to investigate the wonders of the natural world through hands-on activities and games. **NO FEE**

### HOW TO PARTICIPATE

**1. Choose the desired classes with your son/daughter.**

Sign up for as many classes as you wish. Classes are on a first-come, first-serve basis and may be cancelled due to low enrollment. Circle your choices on the course schedule (on back) and keep for your records.

**2. Complete both sides of the registration form below.**

A separate registration form is required for each student. Incomplete forms will delay registration.

**3. Return the registration form along with payment (check, money order, cash) to the main office of your school.**

Please make checks payable to the Manchester School District. A \$30 fee will be assessed for checks returned due to insufficient funds.

### COST

A non-refundable registration fee of \$5 will be assessed for each student enrolling in the afterschool program. The cost for each class is as follows:

\$15 if the student receives free or reduced lunch, \$30 for all others. Unless noted, the fee per course covers the entire session. Families with more than one student enrolled may qualify for reduced rates.

Financial aid and scholarships are available. Please contact your site coordinator for more information.

### THE FINE PRINT

The 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC wants your son's/daughter's after-school experience to be a positive one. Our goal is to provide a fun and safe learning environment for all participants. Please review the following information with your son or daughter.

**BEHAVIOR STANDARDS** - Students participating in the program are held to the Manchester School District's Behavior Standards. Repeated disruptions or disrespect for others and/or for their property may result in removal from the program.

**DISMISSAL** - Students will be dismissed from the program as indicated on your registration form. You must notify the site coordinator in advance if you are unable to pick up your student as designated. Failure to do so will result in a maximum waiting period of thirty minutes. If we are unable to contact you during that time, we may contact local authorities. A late fee of \$5 may be assessed for every fifteen minutes after the designated pick up time.

**ABSENCE FROM PROGRAM** - Time does not allow for parents to be contacted immediately when students are absent from the 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC program. Fees will not be refunded.

**CANCELLATION** - The program does not operate on holidays, school vacation periods or early release days and will be cancelled when schools close due to inclement weather or unforeseen events. Notification will be made through the school's standard procedure. In these cases, courses will not be rescheduled and fees will not be refunded.
