COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

AFTERNOON PROGRAM

Academic Hour (Gr. 1-2): Complete your homework, or work on your school projects with help from our staff. Students **must** bring daily class assignments in order to sign up for this club. **NO FEE**

STEAM (Gr. 1-2)&(3-5): Come work in our new makerspace on STEAM projects in small groups. You'll be integrating arts with science, math, and engineering. **FEE: \$15/\$30**

Nature Lovers (Gr. 1-2) & (3-5): As the weather warms up get outdoors & prep the schools gardens, start to grow a variety of seeds and create nature inspired crafts. **FEE: \$15/\$30**

Coding (Gr. 1-2) & (3-5): The basics of coding will be taught for all grades by Miss Petz. New computer programmers will create their own art, stories and games. Let's see how far they can take their newly learned skills in this interactive and exciting class! **FEE: \$15/\$30**

GIRLS AT WORK (Student Choice) (Gr. 4-5): Join Elaine Hamel and learn woodworking and how to safely use power tools at GAW. In this supportive environment, you will discover self worth, a sense of accomplishment, and the rewards of teamwork. **FEE: \$15/\$30**

Typing 2 Parts (Gr. 3-5): Sharpen your word processing skills in a structured program that uses games to improve your accuracy. **Please sign up for both Monday & Wednesday** **FEE: \$15/\$30**

Sports: Learn about proper stretching, endurance and play sports in an enjoyable and beneficial hour-long club with Mr. Leclerc. **FEE: \$15/\$30**

Math Bingo (Student Choice)(1-2): With a combination of math and bingo, this club allows to practice addition, subtraction, time and money. Lots of fun while learning! **FEE: \$15/\$30**

Journal Making(3-5): Create a journal/scrapbook and document all of your special qualities. There will be an emphasis on self esteem and coping skills. **FEE: \$15/\$30**

Coloring Art(K-2): Color patterns, animals and designs in coloring books. **FEE: \$15/\$30**

Silly Snacks (Student Choice)(4-5): Young chefs will have fun creating tasty and unique recipes that they can later make at home for their families. **FEE: \$15/\$30**

Printmaking (Gr.3-5): Learn to make copies of your art with different printmaking processes with Ms. Provencher. **FEE: \$15/\$30**

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

1. Choose the desired classes with your son/daughter.

Sign up for as many classes as you wish. Classes are on a first-come, first-serve basis and may be cancelled due to low enrollment. Circle your choices on the course schedule (on back) and keep for your records.

2. Complete both sides of the registration form below.

A separate registration form is required for each student. Incomplete forms will delay registration.

3. Return the registration form along with payment (check, money order, cash) to the main office of your school.

Please make checks payable to the Manchester School District. A \$30 fee will be assessed for checks returned due to insufficient funds.

COST

A non-refundable registration fee of \$5 will be assessed for each student enrolling in the afterschool program. The cost for each class is as follows:

\$15 if the student receives free or reduced lunch, \$30 for all others. Unless noted, the fee per course covers the entire session. Families with more than one student enrolled may qualify for reduced rates.

Financial aid and scholarships are available. Please contact your site coordinator for more information.

THE FINE PRINT

The 21st CCLC wants your son's/daughter's after-school experience to be a positive one. Our goal is to provide a fun and safe learning environment for all participants. Please review the following information with your son or daughter.

BEHAVIOR STANDARDS - Students participating in the program are held to the Manchester School District's Behavior Standards. Repeated disruptions or disrespect for others and/or for their property may result in removal from the program.

DISMISSAL - Students will be dismissed from the program as indicated on your registration form. You must notify the site coordinator in advance if you are unable to pick up your student as designated. Failure to do so will result in a maximum waiting period of thirty minutes. If we are unable to contact you during that time, we may contact local authorities. A late fee of \$5 may be assessed for every fifteen minutes after the designated pick up time.

ABSENCE FROM PROGRAM - Time does not allow for parents to be contacted immediately when students are absent from the 21st CCLC program. Fees will not be refunded.

CANCELLATION - The program does not operate on holidays, school vacation periods or early release days and will be cancelled when schools close due to inclement weather or unforeseen events. Notification will be made through the school's standard procedure. In these cases, courses will not be rescheduled and fees will not be refunded.
