

SUMMER CAMP AT PARKER-VARNEY - FOR NORTHWEST, GOSSLER PARK, & PARKER-VARNEY STUDENTS

Time	Daily Schedule	Description
8:00am-9:00am	Breakfast Club	Good morning! Meet your friends for breakfast and get your day started off on the right foot. A healthy and nutritious breakfast will be offered every day!
9:00am-12:00pm	Enrichment Classes	Students will rotate through three, one hour activity periods where they will be engaged in a wide variety of academic, art, science and recreational activities, including cooking, beading, sports, and crafts.
12-12:30pm	Lunch Club	A nutritious lunch will be provided every day!
12:30pm-1:30pm	Recess	Students will enjoy some outside time. They will have the opportunity to participate in structured recess games or free time with their friends.
1:30pm-2:00pm	Kid's Choice	A variety of activities including, board games, arts and crafts, and gym games will be available for students to choose from before their day ends.

THE DETAILS

PROGRAM DAYS AND TIMES: The summer session will operate from July 10th through August 4th, Monday through Friday, 8:00am to 2:00pm. **The program takes place at Parker-Varney Elementary School** for students from Northwest, Gossler Park, and Parker-Varney.

LOCATION: Parker-Varney Elementary School will host the 21st CCLC summer program for students from Northwest, Gossler Park, and Parker Varney elementary schools. No 21st CCLC camp will run at Gossler Park or Northwest schools.

PROGRAM SCHEDULE: From 8:00am-9:00am, students will arrive, check-in, eat breakfast, and prepare for daily activities. From 9:00am-12:00pm participants will rotate through three activity periods. Each activity will last one hour and will focus on academics, arts, and recreation. Lunch will be provided from 12:00pm-12:30pm. Recess from 12:30pm-1:30pm will include structured and unstructured outdoor activities. "Kids Choice" from 1:30pm-2:00pm will provide students with the opportunity to wrap up their day by putting finishing touches on their art projects, participating in sporting activities, and having fun playing their favorite board games.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION: You may register for one, two, three, or four weeks, or you can choose to register by the day.

COST: The summer program is **FREE!** If you would like to make a donation to help support the program, please include your donation amount on the program registration form below.

DISMISSAL: Dismissal from the program will be at 2:00pm. All students must be signed out by an adult designated on your form (unless the student is a walker). Any student who needs to be dismissed before 2:00pm must be signed out by a 21st CCLC staff member. A late fee of \$5 may be assessed for every fifteen minutes beyond the designated dismissal time.

***FYI** Please bring a swimsuit, towel, and shoes that can get wet and sunscreen on Tuesdays and Thursdays!

Gossler Park, Northwest, and Parker-Varney students will attend summer camp at Parker-Varney Elementary School. This is the only summer camp for students from these three schools.
