MORNING PROGRAM
Morning Reading (Gr. K-5): Come join us to explore a new story every morning before school! All grades are welcome! FEE:\$15/\$30
AFTERNOON PROGRAM

FIRST LEGO League (Gr. 4-5): Students will work as scientists and engineers in this year's "Animal Allies" themed robotics club. Teams will build, test, and program a LEGO robot to solve new missions and create a project to solve real-world questions about animals. *This club will run for the rest of the year. No students will be added for session three or four. NO FEE
Tech 4 Kids (Gr. 1-3): Learn internet safety and play fun games on the iPads! NO FEE
Duct Tape Art (Gr. 2-4): Make unique projects with duct tape! (Student Choice) FEE: \$15/\$30
Story and Craft (Gr. K-2): Listen to a great story and then create an art project to go along with it. (Student choice) FEE: \$15/\$30
Sewing Circle (Gr. 3-5): Have you ever wanted to learn how to sew or do other kinds of needle work? This is your chance! Each student will make a project to take home. (Student Choice) FEE: \$15/\$30
Book Buddies (Gr. 1-2): Explore the fun world of reading with friends! NO FEE
Origami (Gr. 2-3): Learn a fun art medium by folding paper and creating 3-D characters with Ms. DiFloures. (Student choice) FEE: \$15/\$30
Kite Making (Gr. K-5): Learn the fun craft of making a kite from scratch with Ms. DiFloures. Please choose the appropriate time. (Student choice) FEE: \$15/\$30
Starfish Corps (Gr. 3-5): Starfish Corps is based on City Year's belief that you are never too young to serve and have a positive effect in your community. Students will participate in games, activities, and community service projects to explore ideas such as peace, healthy choices and environmental awareness. Space is limited. NO FEE

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

1. Choose the desired classes with your son/daughter.

Sign up for as many classes as you wish. Classes are on a first-come, first-serve basis and may be cancelled due to low enrollment. Circle your choices on the course schedule (on back) and keep for your records.

2. Complete both sides of the registration form below.

A separate registration form is required for each student. Incomplete forms will delay registration.

3. Return the registration form along with payment (check, money order, cash) to the main office of your school.

Please make checks payable to the Manchester School District. A \$30 fee will be assessed for checks returned due to insufficient funds.

COST

A non-refundable registration fee of \$5 will be assessed for each student enrolling in the afterschool program. The cost for each class is as follows:

\$15 if the student receives free or reduced lunch, \$30 for all others. Unless noted, the fee per course covers the entire session. Families with more than one student enrolled may qualify for reduced rates.

THE FINE PRINT

The 21st CCLC wants your son's/daughter's after-school experience to be a positive one. Our goal is to provide a fun and safe learning environment for all participants. Please review the following information with your son or daughter.

BEHAVIOR STANDARDS - Students participating in the program are held to the Manchester School District's Behavior Standards. **Repeated disruptions or disrespect for others and/or for their property may result in removal from the program.**

DISMISSAL - Students will be dismissed from the program as indicated on your registration form. You must notify the site coordinator in advance if you are unable to pick up your student as designated. Failure to do so will result in a maximum waiting period of thirty minutes. If we are unable to contact you during that time, we may contact local authorities. A late fee of \$5 may be assessed for every fifteen minutes after the designated pick up time.

ABSENCE FROM PROGRAM —Parents will be contacted by 3:20PM when students are absent from the 21st CCLC Program.

CANCELLATION - The program does not operate on holidays, school vacation periods or early release days and will be cancelled when schools close due to inclement weather or unforeseen events. Notification will be made through the school's standard procedure. In these cases, courses will not be rescheduled and fees will not be refunded.
